Ocean Cruising Seminar

The three day Atlantic Circuit Seminar will take place from 1330 on Friday 11th March to 1600 on Sunday 13th March 2011. It covers in depth, a variety of subjects associated with the planning and preparation required for ocean cruising. Lecturers have been chosen for their wealth of knowledge in their specialist fields. Special emphasis will be on the ARC & World ARC and what to expect in terms of weather and equipment issues. A number of the lecturers have sailed in the ARC and will draw on their experience from their participation in the event. Amongst the subjects to covered are:

- Communications equipment update, including DSC/GMDSS and Sat Coms
- SSB Installation and usage
- Rigging preparation and maintenance; sail choice
- Onboard safety equipment; choosing and using
- Power management and generation
- Choosing and running a Watermaker

- Wind self-steering systems explained
- First aid at sea; techniques and medical supplies
- Spares and maintenance on board
- Provisioning for offshore cruising
- Weather forecasts sources & interpretation
- Heavy weather sailing techniques
- Choosing the right insurance

- As well as the opportunity to ask questions at the end of each lecture, there will be a question and answer forum discussion with a panel of lecturers each day. It is hoped that in this way topics not covered by the lecturers can be brought up and discussed.
- The Holiday Inn in Guildford will be the venue for the seminar. Situated on the A3 the Hotel is easily found. For those arriving by train the main station is close by and well served by buses and taxis.
- One of the additional benefits of the seminar is to meet fellow delegates, many of whom have similar sailing ambitions and plans. There will be a three course dinner on the Saturday evening for delegates to meet one another.

- DATES: The Seminar will take place from 1330 on Friday 11 March to 1600 on Sunday 13 March 2011 at the Holiday Inn, Guildford. Bookings must be received by 11 February; bookings made after this date are not guaranteed accommodation.
- 2. FEES: The seminar fee is £395 per person. Confirmed participants in ARC, Rally Portugal or World ARC are eligible for a reduced rate of £375.
- 3. INCLUDED: The fee includes attendance at the seminar; lecture notes; accommodation as detailed in paragraph 4; lunch, teas and coffees during designated breaks on all days, a buffet dinner on Friday 11th; and the seminar dinner with wine on Saturday 12 March 2011. Travel to and from the seminar venue is not included.
- 4. ACCOMMODATION: the seminar fee includes two nights accommodation at the Holiday Inn, Guildford for the nights of Friday 11 and Saturday 12 March 2010, inclusive of breakfast. The rate is based on two people sharing a twin room. A single room supplement of £40 is payable per night for those not sharing a room. Other hotel services and extras are not included in the seminar fee. A discount of £40 per night will be given off the seminar fee for delegates not wishing to stay at the Holiday Inn on Friday 11 and Saturday 12 March.
- SINGLE ROOM SUPPLEMENT: There is a single room supplement of £40 per person per night occupying a room singly. A minimum of 1 single room supplement is payable for groups of uneven numbers (1, 3, or 5 delegates). Single room supplements are payable at the time of booking.
- 6. GUEST RATE: A guest rate (Saturday night only) of £90 per person is available for anyone wishing to accompany a seminar delegate, but not attend the seminar. The guest rate includes attendance at the seminar dinner; accommodation on the night of Saturday 12 March 2011 inclusive of breakfast. Single room supplement and exclusions apply as per paragraph 4.
- 7. PAYMENT: A deposit of £100 per person is required with booking; the balance is payable eight weeks prior to the seminar start date. Fees may be paid in Pounds Sterling. Cheques should be made payable to WORLD CRUISING CLUB. VISA and MasterCard accepted (3% supplement applies). Bank transfer details are available on request. Bank transfer payments are subject to a bank charge of £7 or equivalent, which should be added to the value of the payment.
- REFUNDS: Refunds will be made for cancellations received by the organisers on the following schedule: 50% for cancellations received by 04/02/2011; 25% for cancellations received from 05/02 until 18/02/2011. No refunds will be made for cancellations received from 19/02/2011, or for delegates or guests who fail to attend for any reason.
- 9. UNUSED SERVICES: For services stated in paragraphs 3,4 and 5 above, there will be no refund for unused services.
- 10. ALTERATIONS TO PROGRAMME: The Organisers reserve the right to alter any aspect of the seminar programme, including content and timings, although such changes will be kept to a minimum. The provisional programme will be sent out with delegate information packs in mid February 2010.
- 11. CANCELLATION: In the unlikely event of the seminar being cancelled all fees paid to the Organisers will be refunded.
- 12. ACCEPTANCE: By making a payment and by signing the booking form, signatories are accepting these terms and conditions for both themselves and, as agent, for all members of the party shown on the booking. The Organisers reserve the right to decline any booking at their discretion.
- 13. TRANSLATION AND LAW: In the event of dispute over translation of the terms and conditions, or any other materials issued by the Organisers, the English language version will prevail. These Conditions shall be governed by the laws of England and the signatory agrees to submit to the exclusive jurisdiction of the English Courts.
